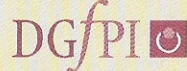

SEXUALISED VIOLENCE HAS MANY FORMS

- sexual abuse in childhood
- attempted/performed rape
- sexual harassment in the digital space

CONSULTATION OFFERS

for affected girls*, boys*, and women*, as well as those supporting the individual.

- personal and telephone counseling
- play therapy for children from 4 years of age
- crisis intervention
- trauma-focused professional counseling
- finding appropriate therapies
- group sessions for stress handling
- facilitating self-help groups

for affected men*:

- initial in-person or telephone consultation
- finding appropriate assistance

for professionals:

- professional counseling for individuals and teams in the event of sexual violence and child endangerment, trauma-informed social work, violence in institutions, development of an institution-specific concept of protection

for children, adolescents, parents and other legal guardians in the field of LGBTTIQ*:

- personal and telephone counselling on issues of sexual orientation and (gender) identity
- finding of special assistance programs

OFFERS FOR PREVENTION

- „Mutig werden mit Til Tiger©“ - group training for children with social insecurities (5-10 years)
- gender-specific work with girls*

- self-defense and self-assertion training for girls* and women* (WenDo)
- training and information events as well as lectures for parents, professionals, and interested parties

WE ...

... believe those affected, take their side and take them seriously. We support you in reducing feelings of shame and guilt. The responsibility for sexual violence lies with the perpetrator.

... offer those affected a space in which they can talk about their experiences without accusations. The people affected decide for themselves what and how much they want to tell.

... start with the personal strengths of the people affected and want to enable them to seek help and prevent further attacks by the perpetrator.

... are subject to professional discretion and will not do anything against the will of those affected or without prior agreement.

... see the causes of sexual violence in society, point them out and name them publicly.

* The gender asterisk represents all people - not only women and men. It "thinks" outside the box and includes people with a trans* and inter* background.
